ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES OF

THE HAMPTON BEACH VILLAGE DISTRICT

MARCH 28, 2003

The annual meeting of the Hampton Beach Village District commenced at 8:00 P.M. on March 28, 2003 at the Hampton Beach Fire Station. Moderator Jim Trainor led the Pledge of Allegiance.

ARTICLE 1: To choose by Australian Ballot one (1) Commissioner to serve for three (3) years; One (1) Supervisor of the checklist to serve for three (3) years; One (1) Moderator to serve for one (1) year; One Clerk to serve for one (1) year; and One (1) Treasurer to serve for one (1) year.

47 votes were cast between the hours of 1:00 P.M. and 8:00 P.M. on March 28, 2003 and the results were:

Commissioner for three years: Mike O'Neil with 43 votes.

Moderator for one year: Tom Higgins with 45 votes.

Clerk for one year: Starr Sullivan with 44 votes.

Supervisor of the Checklist for three years: Joe Williams with 47 votes.

ARTICLE II: To see if the District will vote to accept the budget as submitted by the Budget Committee, and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$400,925.00 for District purposes in addition to any amounts that may be approved for special articles.

 Λ motion was made to pass this article. This motion was seconded and the article was passed.



ARTICLE III: "To see if the District will vote to establish a Capital reserve fund for Playground and Beach Area Improvements and appropriate the sum of \$14,000, to be placed in this fund: Such sum to come from the fund balance (surplus) and no amount to be raised from taxation and to appoint the Commissioners as agents to expend funds from this CRF."

A motion was made to pass this article and the motion was seconded. The article was then voted on and was passed.



ARTICLE IV: "To see if the District will vote to discontinue the Capital Reserve Fund which was created to purchase fire apparatus and related equipment."

A motion was made to pass this article. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

ARICLE V: To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

There was no other business brought before the meeting.
