TRUSTEES OF THE TRUST FUNDS

Regular Meeting, Monday, July 7, 2003, 4 P.M. Selectmen's Meeting Room, Town Office Building Posted (7/3, by A.M.): TOB & Lane Mem. Lib.

PRESENT: "Vic" Lessard, Chairman; "Jack" Kelley, Clerk; Glyn Eastman, Bookkeeper.

Also: Art Moody, Interim Administrative Coordinator; from Banknorth

Investment Management Group: John O'Dowd, V.P. & [R.E.T.F.] Account

Administrator; and, Robert Magan, [R.E.T.F.] Portfolio Manager.

Meeting opened by the Chairman at 4:05 P.M.

Real Estate Trust Fund: Mr. Magan presented the present status and expectations of the fund, going over the extensive folder of information distributed to each Trustee. Discussion with the Trustees. Mr. Moody inquired why the monthly report format was changed since the last one he saw (Feb.'s); he also needs a May report as it was not in the satchel he received from the Bookkeeper. Mr. O'Dowd replied that he would run the appropriate format for this Town board from March through June. MOVED by Mr. Kelley, seconded by Mr. Eastman that the Board authorize/ratify the 1Q03 and 2Q03 fees of \$5,316.90 and \$993.71, respectively. SO VOTED: 3-0-0.

Mr. O'Dowd will send another 1Q03 fee calculation/backup as no one received it. The bank reps departed at 4:45 P.M.


Reorganization of the Board: MOVED by Mr. Eastman, seconded by Mr. Kelley, that the same officers remain in place for the 2003-04 Board year. SO VOTED: 3-0-0. Investment Policy: The annual review of this policy resulted in a motion MOVED by Mr. Eastman, seconded by Mr. Kelley, that the I.P. voted on April 16, 2002, be re-adopted. [Re RSA 31:25.] SO VOTED: 3-0-0.

Other: The I.A.C. gave a brief report; the Trustees signed a few bank papers. The Chairman mentioned a letter from the Register of Charitable Trusts in the Dept. of Justice (NH) re why trusts left to the Winnacunnet School District weren't on our 2002 MS-9s/10. He left a phone message re it's a four-town district, not just Hampton; we never got such a trust for WHSD. A new letter reported it was in the NH Charitable Foundation/Portsmouth (Seacoast) with management there and income each year to the WHSD. Mr. Moody said that the District Meeting has never voted acceptance of that willed trust fund. The AG/CT's second letter stated: "case closed." Mr. Kelley asked about the Radkay mortgage and the Chairman went over what Mr. Radkay is trying to get done; the Town Atty. wasn't able to settle the matter. Mr. Kelley brought up the matter of keeping a certain percentage of the income each year and making it part of the R.E.T.F. principal as "we had voted." Mr. Moody read the Minutes of last Oct. and there was no vote, that the Board was going to hold off for the present (in light of submitted legislation that bypassed Town Meeting). Mr. Lessard said he'll look into its legality. As for the 2004 budget request, Mr. Moody was asked if \$2,100 was acceptable. He said it was: "subject to the unknown requirements/situations of the Jan. audit." Mr. Kelley MOVED, seconded by Mr. Eastman, to submit a \$2,100 budget request for 2004. SO VOTED: 3-0-0. Minutes of Oct. 22, 2002: Mr. Kelley MOVED, seconded by Mr. Eastman, to approve the last Minutes. SO VOTED: 3-0-0.
